The "Big Ocean" phenomenon goes on a solo European tour *1st anniversary of the group launched in April 2024*

Could we imagine a trio as new as this one that revolutionizes for a year the image of KPOP? These three deaf young men are performers who reveal unexpected facets of their personalities in a new opus: "Underwater". They meet their many fans during a tour in 4 countries including France from 19 to 27 April 2025. Focus on artists who change the way we look at disability in particular and music in general.

In their latest EP, Underwater, Big Ocean — the K-pop trio that quickly became a global sensation — returns to Europe. Underwater reveals unexpected sides of these young hard-of-hearing artists who aim to change the perception of disability and music in general. They will meet their many fans during a tour across 4 countries, including France, from April 19 to 27, 2025.

Since then, they've kept busy meeting fans in the U.S., Brazil, Korea, and recently in Nagoya, Japan. Everywhere they go, the same excitement surrounds this trio of performers who sing in English and Korean, and, like all top K-pop groups, deliver complex choreographies—uniquely enriched by the use of International Sign Language. Through their songs, they promote inclusion, and celebrate sharing, connection, pushing one's limits, creativity, and of course, the spirit of community.

A new tour guided by the theme of growth

These three hard-of-hearing and hearing-aid-equipped artists are set on pushing boundaries and championing inclusion in all its forms. They've become true role models, inspiring fans all around the globe.

In each city they visit, tickets will be offered via contests to members of associations for the deaf and hard of hearing. Details on how to enter these giveaways will be revealed within the next 10 days.

But more than that, in their new EP, they deliver another powerful message: real change begins deep within. There is no light without shadow.

It's an ode to acceptance and resilience. The album's subtitle says it all: "When the sun sets, every ocean turns BLACK."

In April, Big Ocean will meet their European fans—known as Pados (350,000 out of their 1 million followers worldwide)—with six shows in Switzerland, France, the UK, and Italy.

April 19–20: Lausanne, Switzerland

They will appear at Polymanga, one of Europe's longest-running conventions, celebrating its 20th anniversary this year. Fans will have the chance to meet them informally for the first time, in addition to two performances in front of 1,500 people.


