



K-Pop Revolution Festival: the new must-attend event

February 21 & 22, 2026 – Mainz, Germany

The K-Pop Revolution Festival will take place in Mainz in 2026 with a line-up that confirms its ambition to play a key role on the European stage of emerging Asian pop trends. An international, bold edition, firmly focused on artists who are reinventing the codes. A closer look at a festival set to become a major European reference.

Founded in 2022 by **Melanie Wery-Sims**, **Proud Nerd** was born from a personal and professional turning point: leaving the political sphere and the desire to create immersive cultural events, designed by fans, for fans. From the outset, the project has been driven by a dual ambition: to offer powerful experiences rooted in popular culture, and—whenever possible—to integrate a charitable or solidarity dimension, giving each event a genuine social impact. The creation of **K-Pop Revolution** marks a new development. Positioned at the crossroads of convention and music festival, the event transposes Proud Nerd's immersive DNA into the world of K-pop.

"K-Pop Revolution is not just a music event: it is a platform for experiences, encounters and communities. Our goal is to renew existing formats and offer a more embodied, more human and more committed approach to K-pop culture in Europe," explains the founder.

A line-up that will turn heads

For this upcoming edition, a first wave of confirmed artists already sets the tone for a diverse, ambitious and culturally rich programme:



- **TRENDZ** – A new K-pop reference, acclaimed across Europe for their explosive performances and cinematic aesthetic.
- **PRIMROSE** – Elegance and choreographic precision, made in Korea; a closely watched return to the stage after a remarkable rise.
- **SUPERTHAI** – T-pop on the rise. A Thai group highly anticipated for its hybrid musicality, flawless visuals and cult-level stage energy among fandoms.
- **ANDREW CHOI** – A leading singer-songwriter who has worked behind the scenes of the K-pop industry for nearly 15 years. He is the voice of Jinu in the phenomenal *KPOP Demon Hunter*.



- **LIM YOUNG MIN** – A Korean solo artist and former member of AB6IX, now developing a more introspective, freer and intimate pop-hip-hop sound.
- **KISU** is a Korean solo artist and former member of 24K. He independently manages his global career and conceives music as a universal language of sharing and human connection.



- **TOP PIYAWAT** – A Thai actor widely recognized for his roles in dramas that have captivated European audiences.
- **XLOV** – A multicultural group with a genderless artistic aesthetic, a fast-growing phenomenon highly anticipated by European fans.



The influencers present :

- **Alexander Bihn** is a Canadian-Korean artist and host, best known as a former member of U-KISS. He is now a recognized international MC and media personality, bridging K-pop, live events and global audiences.



- **Mathewmyworld¹** is a French artist and content creator passionate about K-pop, representing a new generation of European artists inspired by the Korean scene

Together, these artists shape an edition that highlights the diversity of Asian pop scenes—K-pop, T-pop, visual and sonic hybridizations—with a clear ambition: to make Mainz a European crossroads for Asian pop cultures.
